

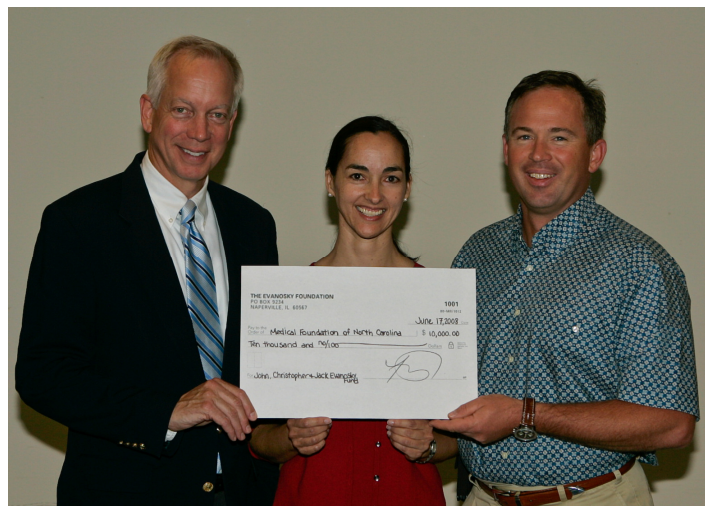

The Evanosky Foundation is pleased to announce the formation of **The John, Christopher, and Jack Evanosky MLD Treatment Fund** at the University of North Carolina - Chapel Hill. The fund will be used solely to provide financial assistance to families with children diagnosed with metachromatic leukodystrophy who are seeking treatment from Dr. Maria Escolar, a well-known expert in MLD progression and care of MLD patients, at the University of North Carolina Center for Development and Learning. The fund, which is currently valued at \$10,000, will be a “last resort” source of funding when all other forms of financial support have been exhausted or denied. The money may be used for travel and lodging expenses, medical evaluations and testing, parking fees, or other items that will help MLD families receive care and treatment from Dr. Escolar. The establishment of this fund supports The Evanosky Foundation’s mission, which includes assisting and caring for children and families affected by MLD.
